LG inaugurates Sidhra-Surinsar road

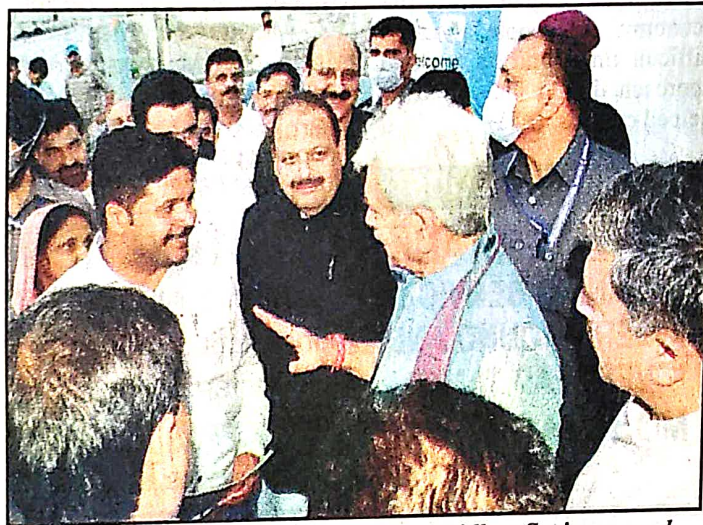
