Status of flyover project in Jammu.

One (1) Flyover is proposed to be constructed from Bikram Chowk Jammu.

The proposed express-way shall have an overall length of 1.30 Km and shall comprise of 4-lane elevated corridor with 4-lane split roads on either flank. The sub-project is estimated to cost Rs.95.50 crores as per the Summary Appraisal Report (SAR) submitted to ADB. This includes cost on account of acquisition of land /structures, rehabilitation of displaced persons, utility-shifting etc. ADB has accorded in principle approval for the sub-project on the condition that all the displaced persons are rehabilitated before commencement of work on the main Flyover.

The sub-project dislocates two business establishments permanently namely Alson Motors and Paramjeet Filling Station of Indian Oil Corporation besides impacting some other properties, mostly Government Departments/Institutions. The permanently displaced parties are proposed to be rehabilitated in the adjoining plot of land presently in possession of J&K State Road Transport Corporation (SRTC). The Government has also issued notice under Section -17 of Land Acquisition Act for acquisition of land and structures coming in the alignment of the Flyover/road-widening.

The work on the Flyover is expected to begin in September-October 2012 upon award of contract and rehabilitation of all displaced parties. The work will be completed in 3 years. $\chi = \Lambda$
