

RBBA suggests measures for timely completion of parking

JAMMU: Raghunath Bazaar Businessmen Association (RBBA) on Wednesday thanked the Governor N.N. Vohra along with Divisional Commissioner Jammu for announcing construction of 7-level parking at Super Bazaar, City Chowk here.

The RBBA said that with this announcement, a long pending demand of the association and other traders in the neighbourhood has been fulfilled.

The construction of the parking at the said space is scheduled to be completed within one year of the beginning of the project which is 1st April this year. The parking place will have capacity for 352 cars and 165 two-wheelers.

A deputation of RBBA led by its president Baldev Khullar called on ERA CEO Vinod Sharma and demanded that to ensure timely completion of the parking project it

is required that the vehicles being already parked at the venue be provided with alternate space.

RBBA suggested that as a temporary measure, these vehicles be allowed to park at various schools and Anqaf land across the city.

These include Maharaja Hari Singh School, Central Basic School, Ranbir Higher Secondary School and DPS Jammu.

The RBBA deputation stated that since the proposed parking is meant only for the

customers coming to city area, proper parking facility for the residents on 24-hr/monthly basis and shopkeepers of the city on 12 hr per day/monthly basis be provided at places like Samadhian Road and behind SMGS Hospital.

While Chief Engineer ERA, Superintendent Engineer ERA and Executive Engineer ERA were also present, General Secretary RBBA Sanjay Sethi besides Joginder Gupta and Vijay Gupta accompanied the deputation.
