1. This Invitation for Bids follows the General Procurement Notice for this project that published in ADB Business opportunity on **2nd April, 2007**.
2. India has received a Loan under Multi-tranch Financing Facility, from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) for financing the Jammu and Kashmir Urban Sector Development Investment Program. It is intended that part of the proceeds of this lone, after ADB’s approval of Project 2, will be used for eligible payments under the contract named below.
3. The J&K Economic Reconstruction Agency invites sealed bids from experienced and eligible bidders for the works of “**Construction of Flyover / Express-way Corridor from Jehangir Chowk to Rambagh – Natipura in Srinagar City**”. The scope of work shall generally include but not limited to the RCC Crash Barrier with hand rail, RCC deck slab with PSC Girders (pre-cast and cast-in-situ)/ PSC deck slab/ RCC deck slab Superstructure, Expansion joint, Bridge bearing, RCC Seismic restrainer, RCC Substructure, Pile foundation, Link road/ Service Road, Rotary, Road divider. Safety Kerb, Drain-cum-footpath, Bus Bays, Diversion of Storm Water Nallah, Lightening arrangement etc. and execution of associated works for successful completion of the works at Srinagar.
4. To be qualified for the contract package, bidder should as a minimum meet the following requirements:
 - (a) average annual construction turnover for last three years equal to or more than INR 750.00 million;
 - (b) meet the cash-flow requirement and overall cash-flow requirements of INR 120.00 million, and INR 1400.00 million respectively;
 - (c) successfully or substantially completed at least two work contracts within the last seven years, each with a value of at least INR 1200.00 million;
 - (d) have executed at least one Contract of construction of major bridge/ flyovers/ grade separator/ ROBs employing Pre-stressed Girders and Pile Foundations in last seven years;
 - (e) meet other financial, personnel and equipment requirements as indicated in the bid document.

However for complete eligibility and qualification requirements, bid document should be referred.

5. International Competitive Bidding (ICB) will be conducted in accordance with ADB's **Single stage - Two envelope** bidding procedure and is open to all eligible bidders from eligible source countries of ADB.
6. In the comparison of Bids, ADB's Domestic preference scheme will be applied in accordance with the provisions stipulated in the Evaluation and Qualification Criteria.
7. Interested eligible Bidders may, inspect the Bidding Documents and obtain further information from office of the undersigned from 11.00 to 16.00 hours on all working days.
8. The interested bidders may purchase the Bidding Document, in English language, on submission of a written application to the undersigned on payment of a nonrefundable fee of Indian Rupees 5,000/- (Rs. Five thousand only) or in equivalent US dollar currency starting from 20th May 2010 to 8th July 2010. Those applicants, who desire to receive the document by courier shall have to pay Rs. 6,000/- (Rupees Six thousand only) for delivery within India, or Rs.7,000/- (Rupees Seven Thousand only) for delivery outside India. The method of payment will be through demand draft in favour of J&K Economic Reconstruction Agency, payable at Srinagar. No liability will be accepted for loss in transit or late delivery.
9. Bidding documents are also available on project website www.jkera.org. Eligible interested bidders can see and download the document and can participate in bidding procedure. Such bidders will submit cost of bidding document along with technical proposal through demand draft in favour of J&K Economic Reconstruction Agency, payable at Srinagar. No bids will be entertained without cost of bidding document.

Bidders intend to download the document from the website and use for submission of bid are requested to visit the website regularly for clarifications/further information or Addendum to the Bidding Document.
10. Bids must be delivered at the address below on or before 1500 hrs on 9th July 2010. Technical bid must be accompanied by the bid security in requisite form amounting to INR 25.00 million. Late bids shall be rejected. Technical bids will be opened on the same day in the presence of the Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the Office of the Project Manager at 1530 hrs.
11. The Economic Reconstruction Agency will not be responsible for any costs or expenses incurred by Bidders in connection with the preparation or delivery of Bids.
12. Pre-bid meeting with the bidders shall be held at **J&K Economic Reconstruction Agency, Hotel Tramboo Continental, 2nd Floor, Dal Gate, Srinagar, Pin 190001** at 1100 hrs on 18th June 2010. Work site visit will be conducted on 17th June 2010 at 1500 hrs. Bidders Interested in participating in bid process are advised to attend pre-bid meeting and visit site before submission of bid.

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
